The Community College Initiative

The Community College Initiative (CCI) is a Department of State sponsored program, which provides participants from underserved areas and underrepresented groups with a one-year, non-degree academic program at a U.S. community college. The program is designed to build participants' technical skills in applied fields, enhance their leadership capabilities, and strengthen their English language proficiency. CCI participants are also required to engage in 100 hours of volunteer work and 75 hours of unpaid experiential learning related to their field of study. Fields of study include business management, early childhood education, public relations, IT, media & journalism, tourism, hospitality, event planning, web development, social media marketing, and construction management.
